SUMMARY:

The position of Product Manager, Extremities identifies market trends, issues, and competitive environment. They will have primary responsibility for driving products from development to commercialization within their segment. This is done by collaborating with the Product Management team to develop strategic marketing plans and training programs to empower the Sales Organization to meet company goals. This position requires experience with external fixation.

- Owns and leads the management of multiple product lines
- Leads the marketing effort to bring new products from concept through commercialization and exit/rationalization
- Develops global product launch plans, including business objectives, product positioning, and key selling messages, such as economic messages
- Develops and maintains a high level of product category knowledge through staying current in industry publications, interacting with surgeons and sales personnel
- Actively participates as a member of a cross-functional team, including development engineering, quality, and process engineering, clinical studies, and regulatory
- Develops product positioning of current product lines
- Performs market and competitive product analyses, including review and analysis of market research to provide guidance on go-to market strategies
- Prepares and delivers product training presentations
- Develops collateral, including but not limited to, surgical techniques and brochures, sales training materials, physician training materials, video production, and product samples and demos
- Prepares forecasts and identifies market shifts and trends
- Provides regular communication to the sales team on market released products and works with sales counterparts to deliver all materials needed to sell the company's products
- Develops working relationships with leading pediatric orthopedic surgeons to analyze their needs and maintains a dialog for current information while abiding by legal guidelines
- Contributes ideas and offers solutions to critical team and departmental issues
- Travels, as reasonably requested, to meet with and educate customers and salespeople, attend and coordinate trade show presence for associated products, attend training programs, coordinate surgeon meetings, and other related travel as determined by the company
- Knows and applies the Quality System and any appropriate federal and international standards
- Assists and supports other employees, teams, and sales personnel, as necessary
